<sup>1</sup> "SCOTT TATTOO" IS A BUGLE CALL ENTITLED "THE TATTOO" FIRST PUBLISHED IN 1835, AND THOUGHT TO BE THE SOURCE OF THE BUGLE CALL KNOWN AS "TAPS". THE CALL WAS PUBLISHED IN MUSICAL NOTATION IN AN AMERICAN MILITARY MANUAL WRITTEN BY MAJOR GENERAL WINFIELD SCOTT, FIRST PUBLISHED IN 1835. THERE MAY BE AN EARLIER BASIS.

ALTHOUGH BRIGADIER GENERAL DANIEL ADAMS BUTTERFIELD COMPOSED "TAPS", USV, DURING THE AMERICAN CIVIL WAR, IT APPEARS TO TRACE ITS DEEPER ORIGIN TO THE "SCOTT TATTOO." IN 1862, GENERAL BUTTERFIELD CALLED UPON PRIVATE OLIVER WILCOX NORTON, HIS BRIGADE BUGLER, TO HELP HIM ADJUST THE PITCH AND TIMING OF NOTES FOR A NEW BUGLE CALL, NOW KNOWN SIMPLY AS "TAPS."
