Memorandum of Understanding between Military Order of the World Wars and Our Community Salutes-USA

This Memorandum of Understanding (the "Memorandum" or "MOU") is made on 10 July, 2025, by and between Military Order of the World Wars, Inc. of 435 N. Lee Street, Alexandria, VA 22314 (hereinafter referred to as MOWW) and Our Community Salutes-USA, Inc. of 41 Cohasset Lane, Cherry Hill, NJ 08003 (hereinafter OCS-USA) for achieving the various aims and objectives hereinafter relating to as the "Partnership."

WHEREAS MOWW and OCS-USA desire to enter into an agreement in which MOWW and OCS-USA will work together to complete the Partnership;

AND WHEREAS MOWW, Inc. and OCS-USA, Inc. are desirous to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding between them, setting out the working agreements that each of the parties agree are necessary to complete the Partnership;

Purpose

The purpose of the Memorandum is to provide the framework for the Partnership between MOWW and OCS-USA. The purpose of the Partnership is to work corporately and jointly to honor and support our nation's high school seniors (and their parents/guardians) who elect to enlist into the military following high school graduation.

Obligations of the Partners

The Parties acknowledge that no contractual relationships is created between them by this Memorandum, but agree to work together in the true spirit of partnership to ensure that there is a united visible and responsive leadership of the Partnership and to demonstrate financial, administrative, and managerial commitment to the Partnership by means of the following individual services.

Cooperation

The activities and services for the Partnership shall include, but are not limited to:

- A. Services to be rendered by OCS-USA include:
 - Providing MOWW with an annual listing of all OCS High School Enlistee Recognition Ceremonies, including dates, locations, times, etc.
 - Inviting a local MOWW member to serve on the OCS Ceremony Planning Team (where applicable).
 - Inviting all MOWW members to attend the OCS Ceremony in their respective communities (where applicable).

- c. To the extent possible, each Party may participate in the development of the Partnership.
- d. Nothing in this memorandum shall obligate either Party to transfer any funds. Any endeavor involving reimbursement or contribution of funds between the Parties to this Memorandum will be handled in accordance with applicable laws, regulations, and procedures. Such endeavors will be outlined in separate agreements that shall be made in writing by representatives of the Parties involved and shall be independently authorized by appropriate statutory authority. This Memorandum does not provide such authority.
- e. This Memorandum is not intended to and does not create any right, benefit, or trust responsibility.
- f. This Memorandum will be effective upon the signature of both Parties.
- g. Either Party may terminate its participation in this Memorandum by providing written notice to other Partner. Such notice shall be effective upon receipt.

Both Parties support the goals and objectives of the Partnership.


